Abstract submission by: 15 September 2026

The requirements of the abstract to be submitted are the following:

The abstract should be between 150 and 200 words in the language used for presentation. Please give five keywords. We recommend that the authors closely follow the substantive and formal guidelines (see Publication guidelines). The abstract of your paper must inform readers about the research you carried out as well as the most important results contained in your paper. The main requirement for your abstract is that it provides the reader a complete, easily understandable summary of the content of your paper. Furthermore, your abstract should provide information about your paper in such a manner that it raises the interest of colleagues from other areas of research.

The abstract should concisely outline, in an academic style, the research problem, the objectives of the study, the methodological framework applied, and the key findings obtained.
